Day	Itinerary Summary
	Arrive in Geneva at 08:15 with Ethiopian Airlines flight ET 726
Sunday 21/06	Take a train to Lyon, Switzerland and from there a bus to Taizé where we will be joining the retreat centre for 7 nights (21/06 - 27/06).
	Join Taizé retreat
Sunday 28/06	Transfer from Taizé to Le-Puy-en-Velay
	The old Le Puy Camino or Via Podiensis is one of the four main pilgrimage routes throug France and is one of the most popular among pilgrims walking the Camino in France.
	The Le Puy Route is stunning and boasts spectacular views of volcanic landscapes an stunning countryside. In terms of scenery, it is known for being one of the most interesting particularly to nature lovers.
	Starting in Le-Puy-en-Velay with its famous Cathédrale Notre-Dame du Puy, where pilgrim can be blessed each morning before starting their pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela
	The route goes from the high plateau of the Massif Central, dropping suddenly to follo the valley of the river Lot, where there is a series of fairy-tale villages.
	Overnight Le Puy
Monday 29/06	Walk Le Puy to St Privat
	Starting at Notre-Dame du Puy Cathedral, modern pilgrims feel a certain emotion when wal ing down the stairs that have been the starting point of thousands of pilgrims en route of Santiago for the last millennium. The day is spent through the rounded green mountains of the Velay massif, offering beautiful scenery all day long, before reaching Saint-Privat d'Allie Climb out of the Puy basin to the Velay Plateau and its volcanic cones and follow the trai route GR 65 - above the Dolaizon river to St Christophe. Cross the Devès, France's large basalt Plateau, via a series of charming villages and arrive at St Privat, with its Roman-sty church and castle vestiges.
	Walking: 17km Overnight: St Privat Dallier
Tuesday 30/06	You climb to a majestic belvedere before gaining Rochegude with its fine hillside chape and castle ruins on the Velay-Gevaudan border. Then descend into the Allier Gorge wit its own 'Pao de Açucar' outcrop before crossing the Eiffel bridge and climbing up past th semi-troglodyte St Madeleine chapel and into the granite mountains of Margeride. Th descent to Saugues is a delight.
	This is a short enough walk but the consequent ascents and descents make it the most do manding stage of this first section. The rewarding side of it is that it offers wonderful view over the Velay massif and the Gévaudan plateau, and we also pass through picturesque villages and hamlets before arriving in Saugues.
	Walking: 28 km Overnight: Sauges
Wednesday 01/07	After breakfast we check out of our hotel and start our return journey home via Lyon. Fligl from Geneva at 20:20
	Overnight: Onboard Flight
Thursday 02/07	Arrive in Cape Town at 13:45.
